

Simple Past Tense

Subject	Verb in past	Object	Subject	Verb to be	Object
I	watched	series yesterday.	I	was	his friend.
+	Structure: Subject + verb in simple past+ object Example: He payed football.		+	Structure: Subject + was/were+ object Example: They were friends.	
-	Structure: Subject + did not + verb in base form+ object Example: He did not pay football.		-	Structure: Subject + was not/were not + object Example: They were not riends.	
Y/N?	Structure: Did+ subject + verb base form+ object Example: Did he pay football?		Y/N?	Structure: Was/were+ subject+ object Example: Were they friends?	
WH?	Structure: Wh+ did + subject + verb base form+ object? Example: When did he play football?		WH?	Structure: Wh+ was/were+ subject+ object Example: Why were they friends?	

Spelling Rules Past Tense

Regular Verbs

Spelling Rules	Examples
Ending in e add d	live – lived stare – stared
Ending in vowel + y add ed	stay – stayed play – played
Ending in consonant + y change y to i and add ed	try – tried carry – carried
One syllable, single vowel and ending in single consonant double the final consonant and add ed	nod – nodded rip - ripped
Two-syllable, stress on second syllable and ending in single consonant double the final consonant and add ed	commit – committed prefer – preferred

different spelling from the base form	go → went eat → ate dig → dug come → came
