a) Study these charts:

Basic level:

<b>TOO</b> + adjective / adverb	This exam is (not) <b>too</b> difficult.
<b>TOO MUCH</b> + uncountable noun	There is <b>too much</b> pollution.
<b>TOO MANY</b> + plural noun	On this road there are <b>too many</b> cars.
adjective / adverb + <b>ENOUGH</b>	This box is (not) <b>big</b> enough.
<b>ENOUGH</b> + noun	We have <b>enough</b> food and chips.

Advanced level:

<b>TOO MUCH</b> + adjective + uncountable noun	There is <b>too much</b> <b>dark paint</b> in this picture.
<b>TOO MANY</b> + adjective + plural noun	There are <b>too many</b> <b>bad people</b> in this neighbourhood.
<b>ENOUGH</b> + adjective + noun	We have <b>enough</b> <b>cold beer</b> .

Compare these examples:

We have enough cold beer.

= We have **enough** beer (there is a sufficient amount of it).

→ We are talking about **quantity**:  
"cold beer" **defines** the kind of beer we have.

We have cold enough beer.

= The beer is cold **enough**.

→ We are talking about a **quality**:  
"cold" **describes** the beer we have.
