


GRAPH DESCRIPTION – REVIEW

The pie charts information about **how much/ the amount of** water was used for different purposes in six regions in the world in 2003.

Overall/ Overview, it / as can be observed from the graph that the of water for industry was the highest in North America and Europe while in the remaining regions, the domestic sector consumed more water as to the others.

In detail, withto the domestic use, Central Asiathe list, with nearly 90% of the total **was/ being** used for this sector. Ranked second **in/ on** the list was Africa, just of South East Asia, **represented/ representing** just over 80% for each. **In/ On** fourth place was South America, where **round/ roughly** three-quarters of the total amount of water was for domestic use.

In **contrast/ contrary, as for/ as regard** the water for industry, top of the list was Europe **although/ however** its figure was slightly larger inwith that of North America, **constituted/ constituting** 53% and 48%

Regards/ Regarding the agricultural use, South America consumed the greatest proportion of water compared to the other regions,nearly a fifth. The othersfrom 7% to 15%.
