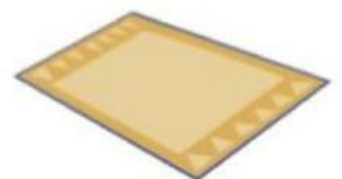

We use *there is* / *there are* to say that something does or doesn't exist.

There is

There are

Use

Used with a singular noun

Used with a plural noun

Example

There is a pillow on the bed.
There is a bed in the bedroom.
There is a lamp on the table.

There are windows in the room.
There are pillows on the bed.
There are blankets on the bed.

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Example

There **isn't** a pillow on the bed.
There **isn't** a bed in the bedroom.
There **isn't** a lamp on the table.

There **aren't any** windows in the room.
There **aren't any** pillows on the bed.
There **aren't any** blankets on the bed.



Note We use **any** when talking about a plural noun that does not exist.

Example There aren't **any** curtains in the bedroom.

Contractions

is not = isn't

are not = aren't
