We can use the **Present Simple** to talk about habits or things that happen regularly.

I/You/We/They **collect** stickers.

He/She **reads** comics.

I **don't** make vlogs.

He **doesn't** build models.

What **do** you **do** in your free time?

What **does** she **do** in her free time?

Do you **play** soccer?

(Yes, I **do**./No, I **don't**.)

Does she **bake** cakes in her free time?

(Yes, she **does**./No, she **doesn't**.)

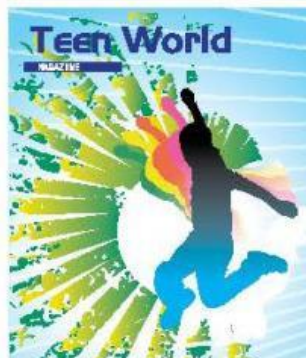
