


Drag the number of the definition to the correct square.



1. Repeat sign, tells you to go back to the beginning
2. Dynamic (Fortissimo), how soft or loud to play
3. Slur, two different notes played in the same bow
4. Accent, an attack at the beginning of the note
5. Clef Sign, tells the player where middle C is
6. Decrescendo, gradually become softer
7. Tie, two of the same notes played in the same bow
8. Staccato, play these notes with a short, stopped bow stroke
9. Bowing signs, shows you when to go down and up bows
10. Legato, played with a smooth, connected bow stroke
11. Time signature, tells how many beats are in a measure
12. Key signature, tells which notes are sharp or flat in the piece
13. Accidental, direction to play a different note than the key indicates
