- I get up at seven o'clock. (*Me levanto a las 7*)
- She gets up at seven o'clock. (*Ella se levanta a las 7*)

Recuerda que con las TERCERAS PERSONAS (HE / SHE / IT) tienes que aplicar las reglas básicas del presente simple:

- Con la mayoría de verbos: añadimos -s
- Verbos acabados en -ch, sh, -s, -ss, -x or -z: añadimos -es
- Verbos acabados en consonante + y: -y cambia a -ies
- Verbos acabados en vocal + y: se añade -s
- Verbos como "go" y "do": añaden -es
- Verbo "have": cambia a has
