<b>Not at all</b>	Not in any way; not to any degree
<b>Not believe one's ears (or eyes)</b>	Be unable to believe what one hears (or sees)
<b>Not think much of</b>	Not like; not have a good opinion of
<b>Odds and ends</b>	Small, miscellaneous items
<b>An old hand (at)</b>	An experienced person
<b>On edge</b>	nervous
<b>On end</b>	Consecutively, without a break (days on end, for example)
<b>On hand</b>	Easily available
<b>On needles and pins</b>	Nervous; anxious
<b>On one's own</b>	independent
