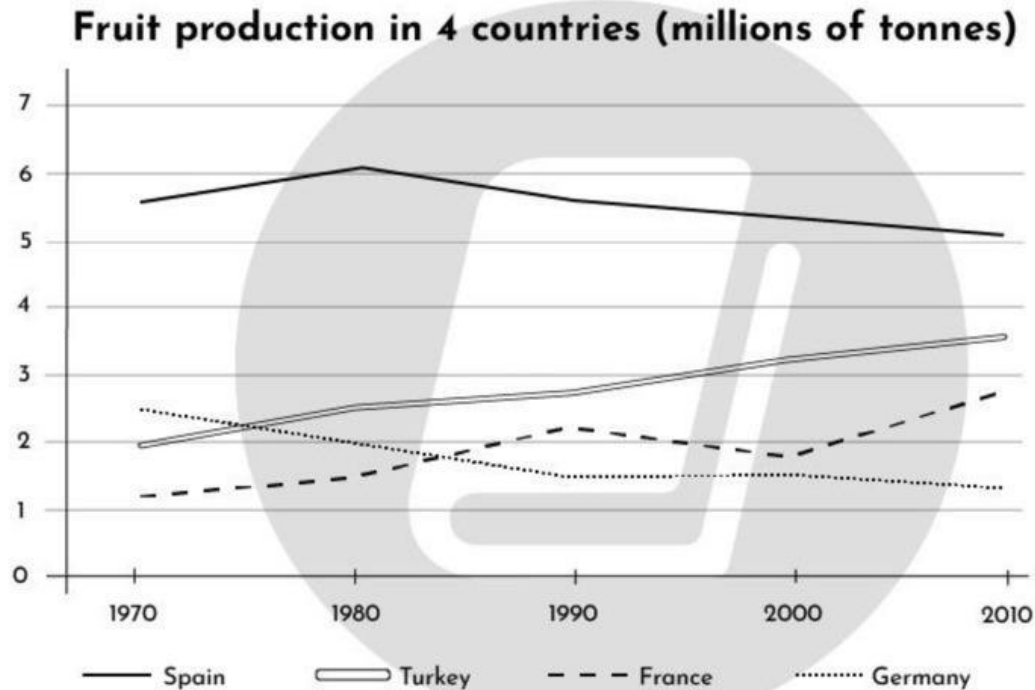


The graph shows the amount of fruit produced in four countries
(France, Spain, Germany, Turkey) from 1970 to 2010



- As can be seen from the graph, the production of fruit in Spain and Germany saw **downward trends/ downward trend** while the others experienced went up over the period question.
- risen slightly to just over 6 million tonnes in the first 10 years, the production of fruit in Spain witnessed a **gradual/ gradually** decline roughly 10m tonnes over the **last/late** 30 years.
- Despite a **marginal fall/ fell marginally** from 1990 to 2000, the figure France a **significant rise/ rose significantly** over the period a whole, **reached/ reaching** just under 3m tonnes in 2010.

- for Turkey and France, while the **former/ latter** went up **constant/ constantly** to around 3.5m tonnes, the **former/ latter** witnessed a fractional **decrease/ decreasing** between 1990 2000, **following/ followed** by a **recover/ recovery** to just under 3m tonnes in 2010.
- The fruit production in Germany went down stably from **rough/ roughly** 2.5m to 1.5m tonnes during.....first 20 years, after **which/that** it almost remained **constant/ constantly** at this level over the last 20 years of the period.
- The fruit production in Spain experienced a **stable/stably** growth over the period **cover/ covered** by the graph, **increased/ increasing** to approximately 3m tonnes in 2010.
