
## QUESTIONS

- **INFORMATION QUESTION** - How was your weekend?
- **YES/NO QUESTION** - Was it fun?
- **TAG QUESTION** - That was fun, wasn't it? (Synonym to: right?)

*Uli, you forgot about our lesson, didn't you?*

*Juan, you've studied a lot, haven't you?*

*Ani, you like cats, don't you?*



## AUXILIARIES

TENSE	AUXILIARY	EXAMPLE
Present Simple (TO BE: AM, IS, ARE) Present Descriptions or States	TO BE (AM, IS, ARE)	<i>Are you happy?</i> <i>How tall is he?</i> <i>He's at school, isn't he?</i>
Present Simple	DO/DOES	<i>Do you like pasta?</i> <i>What does she do?</i> <i>You love One Direction, don't you?</i>
Present Continuous	TO BE (AM, IS, ARE)	<i>Is Ulises paying attention?</i> <i>What are Valu and Tony doing?</i> <i>Juan is studying, isn't he?</i>
Present Perfect	HAVE/HAS	<i>Have you finished?</i> <i>Where has she been?</i> <i>You haven't done the homework, have you?</i>
Past Simple (TO BE)	TO BE: WAS/WERE	<i>Was Juan happy?</i> <i>What were Benja and Belu doing?</i> <i>Uli was sleeping, wasn't he?</i>
Past Simple (OTHER VERBS)	DID	<i>Did you eat pasta?</i> <i>What did Ana do yesterday?</i> <i>Eli ate chicken, didn't she?</i>
Past Continuous	TO BE: WAS/WERE	<i>Was Eli drawing?</i> <i>Where was Tao playing?</i> <i>Was Tony studying yesterday?</i>
Past Perfect	HAD ( <b>d</b> )	<i>Had you seen Tony before meeting with Belu?</i> <i>What had you done before that?</i> <i>Valu had lost the keys, hadn't she?</i>
Future (WILL)	WILL	<i>Will you go to the party?</i> <i>Where will you be?</i> <i>You won't eat here tonight, will you?</i>

**Comentado [1]:** It depends on the subject. If the subject is SINGULAR (he/she/it), DOES. If the subject is "I", "YOU" or PLURAL, DO.

**Comentado [2]:** It depends on the subject.

**Comentado [3]:** 'd + infinitive: WOULD  
'd + past: HAD

Future (GOING TO)	AM/IS/ARE	<i>Are you going to visit Ana tomorrow?</i> <i>What is Belu going to do next weekend?</i> <i>Benja is going to visit Uli, isn't he?</i>

Uli will visit Benja, won't he?


You go to Armonía School, DON'T you?


