Present Yes-No Q's	<i>clause if + simple past</i>		
He: "Do you know the victim?"	a. He asked me if I knew the victim.	b. He asked me if I have knew the victim.	c. He asked me if I know the victim.
Simple past was-were	<i>clause if + past perfect</i>		
She: "Were you with your friends yesterday?"	a. She asked if he been with his friends the night before.	b. She asked if he had been with his friends the night before.	c. She asked if he had being with his friends the night before.
Yes-No Q's + simple past	<i>simple past</i>		
He: "Is the coat with blood yours? We found it under your bed."	a. He asked if the coat with blood was his.	b. He asked if the coat with blood were his.	c. He asked if the coat with blood was him.
Present Perfect	<i>present perfect</i>		
She: "How many crimes have you solved?"	a. She asked him how many crimes he had solve.	b. She asked him how many crimes he has solved.	c. She asked him how many crimes he solved.
Wh-Q's + did	<i>past perfect</i>		
She: "Why did you become a detective?"	a. She asked him why he become a detective.	b. She asked him why he became a detective.	c. She asked him why he had become a detective.
