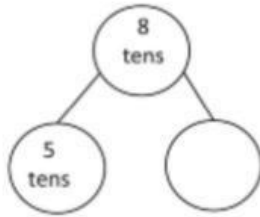


1. $8 \times 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



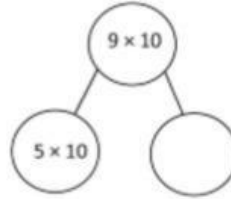
5 tens + $\underline{\hspace{2cm}}$ = 8 tens

$(5 \times 10) + (\underline{\hspace{1cm}} \times 10) = 8 \times 10$

$50 + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$8 \times 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

3. $9 \times 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$



5 tens + $\underline{\hspace{2cm}}$ = 9 tens

$(5 \times 10) + (\underline{\hspace{1cm}} \times 10) = 9 \times 10$

$\underline{\hspace{2cm}} + \underline{\hspace{2cm}} = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$

$9 \times 10 = \underline{\hspace{2cm}}$
