Must and Mustn't

We use **must** for obligation, or things you have to do. We use the negative form **must not (mustn't)** for prohibition, or things you should not do. Like other modals (such as **can**, **may**, **might** and **should**), **must** and **mustn't** have the same form for all persons and are followed by the base form of the main verb.

Obligation You (1)..... follow the rules.

Prohibition People (2)..... break the law.






