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Present Simple

We use the present tense



- For repeated or regular actions in the present time period

I **take** the train to the office.

The train to Berlin **leaves** every hour.

John **sleeps** eight hours every night during the week.

- For facts

The President of The USA **lives** in The White House.

A dog **has** four legs.

We **come from** Switzerland.

- For habits

I **get up** early every day.

Sara **brushes** her teeth twice a day.

They **travel** to their country house every weekend.

- For things that are always / generally true.

It **rains** a lot in winter.

The Queen of England **lives** in Buckingham Palace.

They **speak** English at work.

Present Simple

We form the present tense using the base form of the infinitive (without the TO).

✓ In general, in the third person (she/he/it) we add 's' in the third person.

Subject	Verb	The Rest of the sentence
I / you / we / they	speak / learn	English at home.
he / she / it	speaks / learns	English at home

1. For verbs that end in -O, -CH, -SH, -SS, -X, or -Z we add **-ES** in the third person.

- go – goes
- catch – catches
- wash – washes
- kiss – kisses
- fix – fixes
- buzz – buzzes

2. For verbs that end in a consonant + Y, we remove the Y and add **-IES**.

- marry – marries
- study – studies
- carry – carries
- worry – worries

3. There are also a few verbs that are irregular in the present simple:

- **have** becomes **has**
- **do** becomes **does**
- **go** becomes **goes**

NOTE: For verbs that end in a vowel + Y, we just add **-S**.

- play – plays
- enjoy – enjoys
- say – says

Present Simple

To make the **negative** form,
you need to use '**do not**' (**don't**)
or '**does not**' (**doesn't**).

Negative (of 'play')

I **do not** play

I **don't** play

you **do not** play

you **don't** play

he **does not** play

he **doesn't** play

she **does not** play

she **doesn't** play

it **does not** play

it **doesn't** play

we **do not** play

we **don't** play

they **do not** play

they **don't** play

Note: when you use does, does not or doesn't,
use the base form (without 's')

Present Simple



Make negative present simple sentences.

Use contractions don't or doesn't to make sentences negative.

1. (I/ not/ like coffee)



2. (I/ not/live in Paris)

Present Simple



How about the **question** form of the present simple tense?

- We use 'do' or 'does' before the subject to make the **'yes / no' question**:

Yes / No questions

do I **play** ?

do you **play** ?

does he **play** ?

does she **play** ?

does it **play** ?

do we **play** ?

do they **play** ?

- to make a **'wh' question**, you just put the question word at the front:

Wh Questions

Where **do** I **play**?

what **do** you **play** ?

why **does** he **play**?

who **does** she **play**?

when **do** we **play**?

how **do** they **play** ?
