Answer the questions:

1. How many seasons are there in a year? What are they?
2. Which is the coldest season?
3. Which is the hottest season?
4. What are winter/ spring/ summer/ autumn months?

Climate in Ukraine

Ukraine has a mostly **mild** climate, but there are some places with **different** kinds of weather. One example is the Southern Coast of Crimea, which has a **warm** and sunny climate like you might find in the Mediterranean. In general, Ukraine gets a **good amount** of sunshine and rainfall all year round, but during the summer months from May to August, it tends to rain the most. The amount of rain can **vary** depending on where you are in the country and the time of year.

On average, Ukraine's **yearly** temperature is around 7-9°C. During the summer months, from May to August, the temperatures **range** from less than 18°C to 22°C. In winter, from December to March, it gets colder, and the temperatures range from -4.8°C to 2°C.

When it comes to rainfall, most of it happens during the summer and **fall** months. In particular, June and July usually have the highest amount of rainfall, around 67 millimeters.

Remember, weather can change from year to year, so these are just **general** patterns for Ukraine's climate.
