Important Points.

1. All living things need **food to get energy**.
2. Plants **make their own food in their leaves**, while animals **either eat plants or animals**.
3. **Herbivores** are animals that **eat only plants**. **Cows, buffaloes, horses, rabbits and giraffes** are examples of herbivores.
4. **Carnivores** are animals that **eat other animals**. **Lions, wolves, tigers, dolphins and snakes** are examples of carnivores.
5. **Omnivores** are animals that **eat both plants and animals**. **Bears, humans, rats and crows** are examples of omnivores.
6. A chain which tells us who eats what in nature is called **food chain**.
7. **All food chains start with plants. All animals finally depend on plants for their food.**
8. Animals have **mouth parts suited** to the **type of food** they eat.
9. **Herbivores** have **sharp and broad front teeth** to bite off the grass.
10. **Carnivores** have **long, sharp and pointed teeth** to tear flesh.
11. Both **herbivores and carnivores have flat back teeth** to chew their food.
12. **Snakes can swallow animals bigger than their own heads**. When they have to swallow a large animal, **their jaws open out** and the mouth becomes very big.
13. **Snakes, lizards and frogs swallow their food without chewing**.
14. **Chameleons and frogs have a long and sticky tongue** to catch insects.
15. A **mosquito** has a **sharp and hollow tube** in its mouth to **suck blood**.
16. A **butterfly** has a **long and hollow tube** to **suck nectar**.
17. The **tube like mouth** of butterfly or mosquito is called **proboscis**.
18. **Turtles and tortoises do not have teeth**. They use their **beaks** to eat their food.

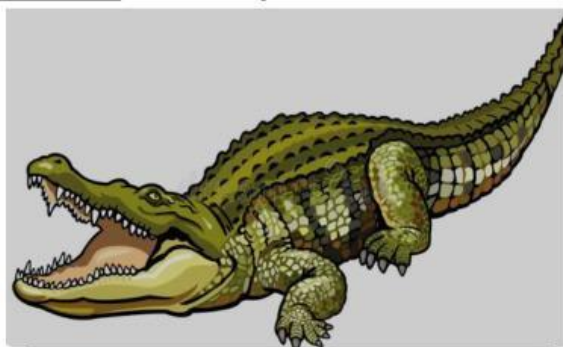
