Justin Bieber is a Canadian singer and songwriter. He was born on March 1, 1994. He is the only child of Jeremy Bieber and Patricia Mallette. Bieber's parents were never married. Patricia educated her son with the help of her mother and stepfather. Bieber attended a French-language elementary school in Stratford, Ontario. He learned to play the piano, drums, guitar, and trumpet. In 2007 Bieber sang for a local singing competition in Stratford. His mother posted a video of the performance on YouTube for their family and friends to see. She continued to upload videos of Bieber singing covers of various R&B songs, and Bieber's popularity on the site grew.
