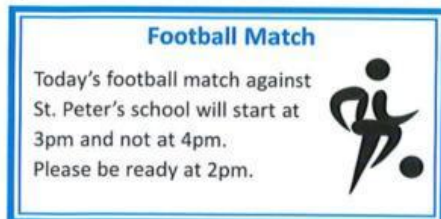

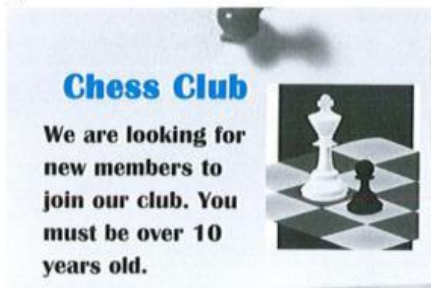

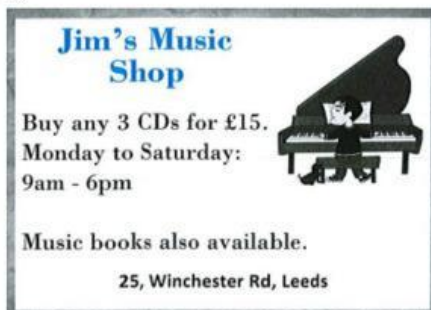

Three Cars

Ruscon, family car

Ruscon has a big engine and this makes it possible to go on long trips. The car has eight seats which includes the driver's seat. There is plenty of room in the back for luggage. The seats in the back have DVD players so the children can watch films during the journey. Each seat has its own screen. This car is very cheap to run but can be a little bit expensive to buy. Nican, city car

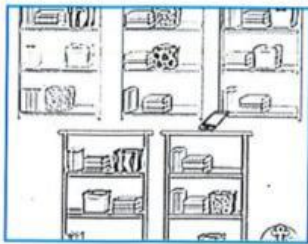

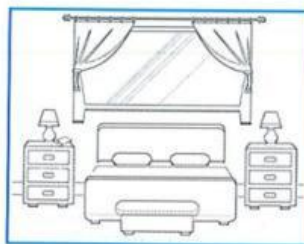

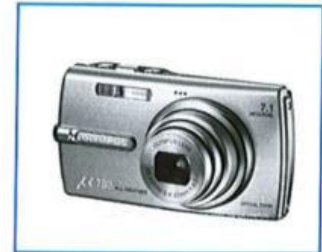
