PRESENT SIMPLE THIRD PERSON SINGULAR VERB ENDINGS

- The third person pronouns have different format in the present simple.
- There are some rules:

PRESENT SIMPLE THIRD PERSON SINGULAR VERB ENDINGS

- 1) Add **-s** to most of the verbs.

Bob writes letters every day.
Daniel cleans his bedroom every Saturday.
My mother cooks very well.
Sarah plays volleyball very well.
It takes few minutes to prepare a pancake.

PRESENT SIMPLE THIRD PERSON SINGULAR VERB ENDINGS

- 1) Add **-s** to most of the verbs.
- 2) Add **-es** if the verb ends in:

-TCH - He watches TV.
-CH - She teaches English.
-SH - He washes his clothes.
-SS - She misses her friends.
-O - He goes to school.
-X - Karen fixes bicycles.
-Z - The bee buzzes.

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PRESENT SIMPLE THIRD PERSON SINGULAR VERB ENDINGS

3) Verbs that end in "-Y", change the "Y" to "I" before adding "-ES" if there is a consonant before "-Y".

Christian hurries to work.

Elizabeth studies English.

My friend worries too much.

For verbs that end in '-y', and are preceded by a vowel (a,e,i,o,u) , do **NOT** change the 'y' to 'i'.

- She plays soccer. / He buys lunch.
