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Can housework make us healthier?

If you ¹ _____ about going to the gym but you can't find time and energy to make the first move, here's some good news. According to a new study, doing housework can be an excellent alternative to weight ² _____, especially when it comes to cutting the risk of heart problems.

A team of scientists discovered that people who worked out in the gym were as fit as those who ³ _____ household chores. Interestingly, however, those who chose some of the less energetic jobs, such as ironing or dusting, often put on weight. The reasons are not clear, though. One theory is that when we clean the house, we tend to snack more, because the fridge is only a few steps away.
