7. **A pain in the neck.** Patricia is a nuisance, and is always annoying people.



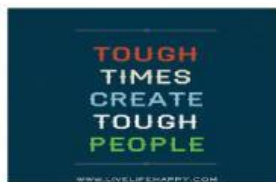
8. **A cold fish.** Freddie is rather unfriendly, and seems to have no strong feelings.
