The simple future tense refers to actions or events that will happen in the future. This allows us to express predictions, intentions, and expectations. Using this grammatical tool, we can shape our thoughts, decisions and actions.

Simple Future

The future simple in English indicates a **time later than the present**. Nothing more and nothing less. We use it to **talk about actions, facts and certainties that will take place in a time subsequent to the present** (although now we will see its specific uses later). In Spanish it would be equivalent to the future indicative.

Subject + will + verb

I **will** work harder next time.



Subject + will + not + verb

I **will not** give him the prize.
