<u>fertile</u>		extremely big
<u>vast</u>		an event, esp. one that happens unexpectedly
<u>sparse</u>		being the only existing one of its type or, more generally, unusual, or special in some way
<u>expanse</u>		able to produce a large number of something (e.g. fruit, vegetables, ...) because it's a good place to grow stg.
<u>remoteness</u>		extremely small in growth
<u>unique</u>		acceptable or right for someone or something
<u>provide</u>		a large, open area of land, water, or sky
<u>consultation</u>		to try to do something, especially something difficult
<u>require</u>		small in numbers or amount, often spread over a large area:
<u>suitable</u>		to give someone something that they need
<u>supply</u>		an amount of something that is available for use (e.g. water, food, ...)
<u>occurrence</u>		a meeting to discuss something or to get advice
		being far away in distance, far away from any town or city
