## Should vs. Could

When do we use "could" and "should"?

**Could** = It is a modal verb used to express possibility as to make **suggestions** and requests.

**Should** = It is a modal verb used to give advice. When we tell other people what we think could help them.

*Should* gives stronger advice than *could*.
