A NOBLE GIFT



1-One of the most famous monuments in the world, the
2-Statue of Liberty, was presented to the United States of
3-America in the nineteenth century by the people of
4-France. The great statue, which was designed by the
5-sculptor August Bartholdi, took ten years to complete.
6-The actual figure was made of copper supported by a
7-metal framework which had been especially
8-constructed by Eiffel. Before it could be transported to
9- the United States, a site had to be found for it and a
10- pedestal had to be built. The site chosen was an
11-island at the entrance of New York Harbour. By 1884,
12- statue which was 151 feet tall, had been erected In
13- Paris. The following year, it was taken to pieces and
14- sent to America. By the end of October 1886, the statue had been put together again and was
15-officially presented to the American people by Bartholdi. Ever since then, the great monument has
16-been a symbol of liberty for the millions of people who have passed through New York Harbour to
17-make their homes.
