

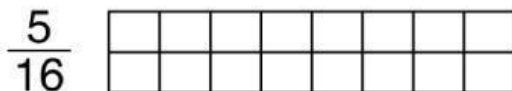
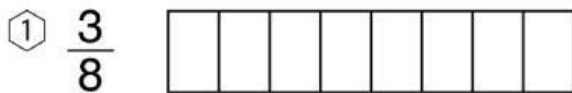
Benchmark Fractions

$$\frac{1}{2} > \frac{1}{4}$$



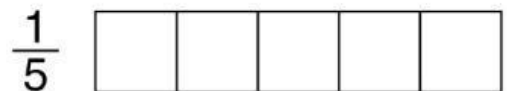
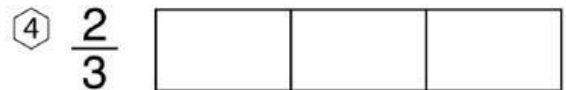
$$\frac{3}{8} \bigcirc \frac{5}{16}$$



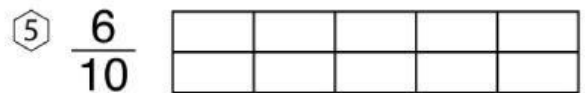
$$\frac{6}{7} \bigcirc \frac{8}{14}$$



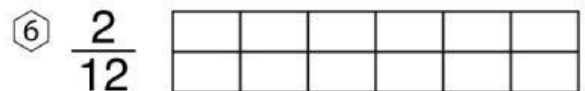
$$\frac{5}{6} \bigcirc \frac{2}{8}$$
