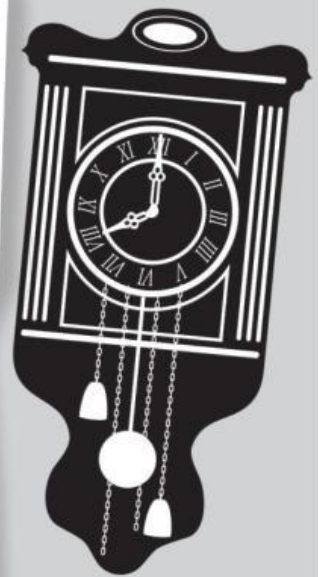


The Secret of the **Old Clock** by Donna Hanson
