

Analytical Exposition

- Definition : a text that elaborates the writer's idea about the phenomenon surrounding.
- Social Function : Its social function is to persuade the reader that the idea is an important matter
- Generic Structure:

Thesis : Introducing the topic and indicating the writer's point of view.

Argument : Explaining the argument to support the writer's position. The number of arguments may vary, but each argument must be supported by evidence and explanation.

Reiteration : Estating the writer's point of view / to strengthen the thesis. We can use the following phrase to make conclusion in reiteration

- **Language Feature of Analytical Exposition Text**

1. Using relational process : to be, become, smell, come, make, refer to, seem
2. Using internal conjunction : besides, in addition, further, but, meanwhile, on the other hand, second, then, next
3. Using causal conjunction : although, but, because, because of, since, for.
4. Using Simple Present Tense

Global warming

Global warming is the increase in the average temperature of the Earth's near-surface air and oceans in recent decades and its projected continuation. Increasing global temperature will cause sea levels to rise, and is expected to increase the intensity of extreme weather events and to change the amount and pattern of precipitation. Other effects of global warming include changes in agricultural yields, trade routes, glacier retreat, species extinction and increases in the ranges of disease vectors. Remaining scientific uncertainties include the amount of warming expected in the future, and how warming and related changes will vary from region to region around the globe. Most national governments have signed and ratified the Kyoto Protocol aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions, but there is ongoing political and public debate worldwide regarding what, if any, action should be taken to reduce or reverse future warming or to adapt to its expected consequences.

Climate model projections summarized by the IPCC indicate that average global surface temperature will likely rise a further 1.1 to 6.4 °C (2.0 to 11.5 °F) during the twenty-first century. The range of values results from the use of differing scenarios of future greenhouse gas emissions as well as models with differing climate sensitivity. Although most studies focus on the period up to 2100, warming and sea level rise are expected to continue for more than a thousand years even if greenhouse gas levels are stabilized.
