A. Article



How to use them?

We can use articles before nouns.

Kita bisa menggunakan "article" sebelum kata benda

Example:

I see a lion and an elephant on safari.
The lion is scary.

The first time we mention a noun, we use a or an. The next time, we use the.

Kali pertama kita menyebutkan sebuah kata benda, kita menggunakan a atau an. di waktu selanjutnya kita menggunakan the.

Example:

I always bring an umbrella. The umbrella is in my bag.
My friend has a new watch. The watch is black.

We use a and an with singular nouns. We use a before a consonant sound and an before a vowel sound.

Kita menggunakan a dan an dengan kata benda tunggal. kita menggunakan a sebelum kata benda yang diawali bunyi konsonan dan an sebelum kata benda yang diawali bunyi vokal (a,i,u,e,o)

Example:

There's a big umbrella and an orange pencil case in my bag.

We don't usually use articles for people's names, countries or meals.

Kita tidak biasa menggunakan article untuk nama orang, negara atau makanan.

My best friend is Mai.

Is she from Japan?

They had breakfast at 9 o'clock.

- Positive sentence (kalimat positif)
(+) He has a sharp nose.
- Negative sentence (Kalimat negatif)
(-) He does not have a shrap nose.
- Interrogative sentence (Kalimat tanya)
(?) Does he have a sharp nose?

Any plural subject

Example:

- Positive sentence (kalimat positif)
(+) They have blue eyes.
- Negative sentence (Kalimat negatif)
(-) They do not have blue eyes.
- Interrogative sentence (Kalimat tanya)
(?) do they have blue ayes?
