The USA wanted to reduce its **spending on defence**. The war in Vietnam was a disaster both financially and with public relations. They hoped that a thaw in hostilities between the USA and the USSR would help the USA negotiate a peace.




C

China was beginning to communicate with countries in the West and Brezhnev wanted to prevent China allying with the USA.

The USA faced protests and riots triggered by the **Civil Rights movement** led by Dr Martin Luther King. If the Cold War died down the USA would be able to focus on domestic issues.

Basic Principles Agreement – rules for nuclear warfare, agreed to “make every effort to avoid this risk”

Agreed to restrict missile launchers and strategic bombers

Anti-Ballistic Missile Treaty – ABMs only at 2 sites, max 100.
