


CODITIONAL SENTENCES - IF CLAUSES, TYPE 1

Now read the sentence: If we play well, we will win the game.

☞ This sentence has two parts and it expresses something that may possibly happen:

- 1 – If we play well,... ⇒ starts with "IF" and express a condition.
- 2 - ...we will win the game. ⇒ expresses the consequence of the if-clause.
