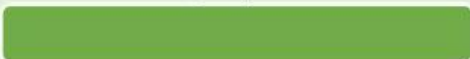


EFIS – the Electronic \_\_\_\_\_

*consists of an LCD Screen and a Keyboard*

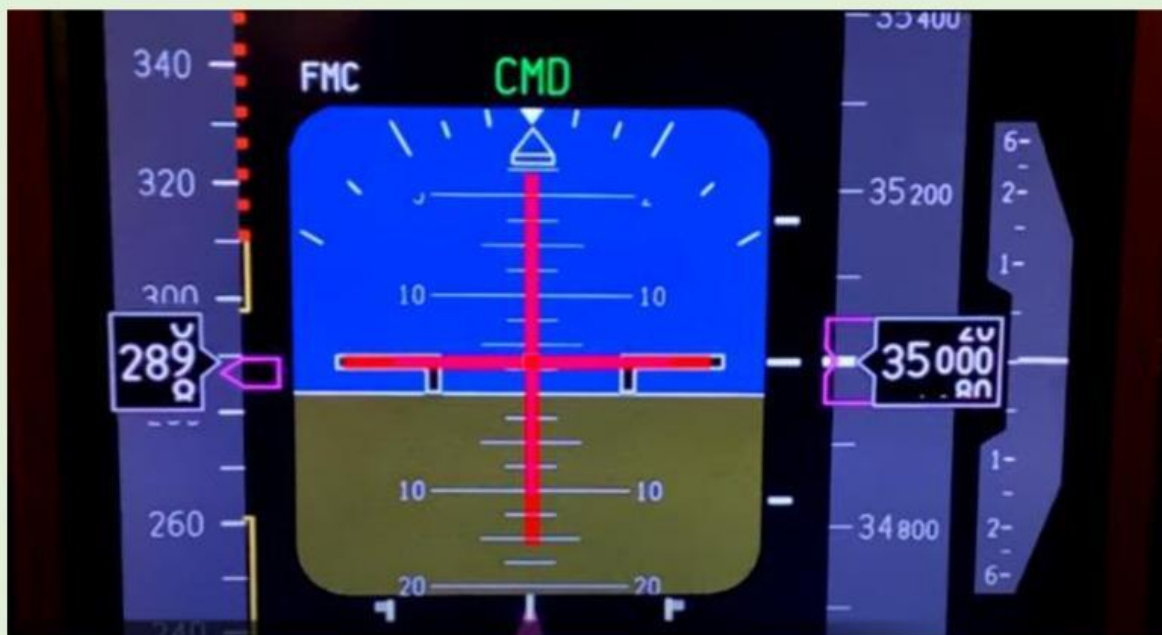
**the little graphical aid in front of the artificial
