The origin of Kinder Surprise is attributed to Michele Ferrero, the owner of the Ferrero Chocolates company. However, some experts attribute it to William Salice, Michele Ferrero's right-hand man and who collaborated with the businessman in the launch of several brand products.

Michele Ferrero wanted to make a chocolate that had the fun of Easter for any day of the year, officially launching the Kinder Surprise chocolate in 1974, being a resounding success in sales and retaining its popularity several decades after its launch. The concept of the Kinder Surprise egg has been consolidated over several generations, so its toy has represented different animals, means of transportation, characters from children's animations and soldiers.

On the other hand, Kinder Surprise toys have become collector's items for several adults, due to the limited edition toys that include small pieces to assemble different objects.
