

Temporary stay

Returns to own country

May stay for weeks or years

Repatriation to own country

Forced deportation to own country

Granted asylum in new country

Refugees/asylum seekers: forced to move by war, famine, disaster, fear or persecution

Temporary move for work reasons

Voluntary individual move for work

Permanent move for work or quality of life reasons
