


# Present Simple!



AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE**	INTERROGATIVE
I <b>walk</b>	I <b>don't walk</b>	<b>Do I walk?</b>
You <b>walk</b>	You <b>don't walk</b>	<b>Do you walk?</b>
<b>She walks*</b>	<b>She doesn't walk</b>	<b>Does she walk?</b>
<b>He walks*</b>	<b>He doesn't walk</b>	<b>Does he walk?</b>
<b>It walks*</b>	<b>It doesn't walk</b>	<b>Does it walk?</b>
<b>We walk</b>	<b>We don't walk</b>	<b>Do we walk?</b>
<b>You walk</b>	<b>You don't walk</b>	<b>Do you walk?</b>
<b>They walk</b>	<b>They don't walk</b>	<b>Do they walk?</b>
