Dubai Mall

There is nothing small about Dubai Mall. It's in the centre of the city of Dubai and it's over 1.2 million m² – that's the size of 50 football fields! Over 80 million people visit every year. It's modern and very clean. Many people shop there, but it doesn't seem crowded because it's so big.

There are over 1,300 shops, including clothes shops, games shops and electronics (mobile phones and computers). The Souk is an area with around 200 small shops that sell typical things from Dubai, so it's a great place to buy things for family and friends.
