Present simple

and

Present continuous



(+) → I wear a uniform.
She wears a uniform.
 (-) → I **don't** wear a uniform.
 She **doesn't** wear a uniform.
 (?) → **Do** you wear a uniform?
 Yes, I do. / No, I don't.
Does she wear a uniform?
 Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.

(+) → I'**m playing** handball.
 She **is playing** handball..
 (-) → I'**m not playing** handball.
 She **isn't playing** handball.
 (?) → **Are** you **playing** handball.?
 Yes, I am. / No, I am not.
Is she **playing** handball.?
 Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.

Time expressions:

- Every day / week / year ...
- On Mondays.
- In the morning / afternoon ...
- At 1 o'clock / half-past two.
- Once a day / week / ...
- Twice a day / week / ...
- Three/four/ten times a ...

Time expressions:

- Now.
- Today.
- At the moment.
