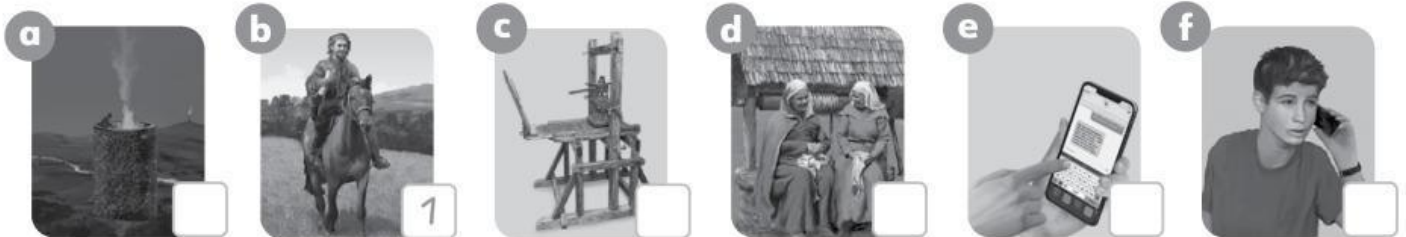

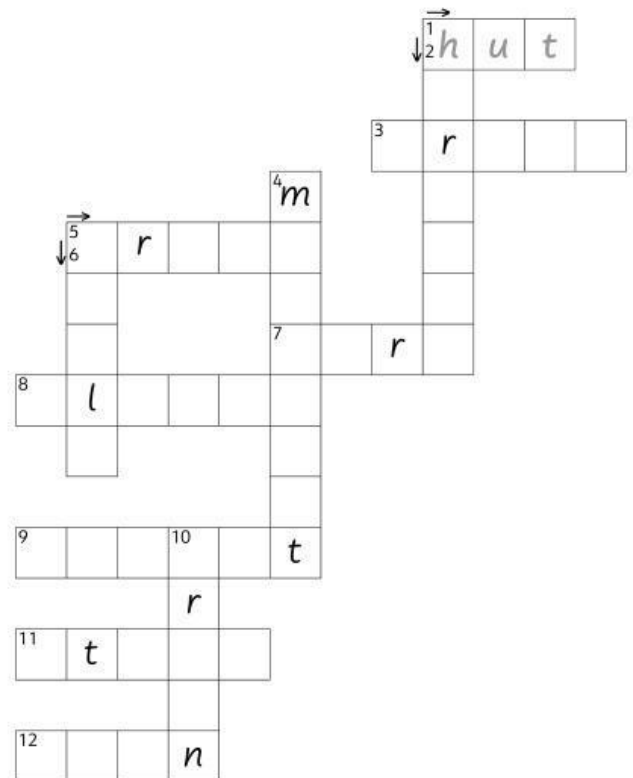
Alex: That's only because her new phone is different from her old one. Anyway, I think we shouldn't spend so much time on our phones. We should meet and ² _____ to people more.
