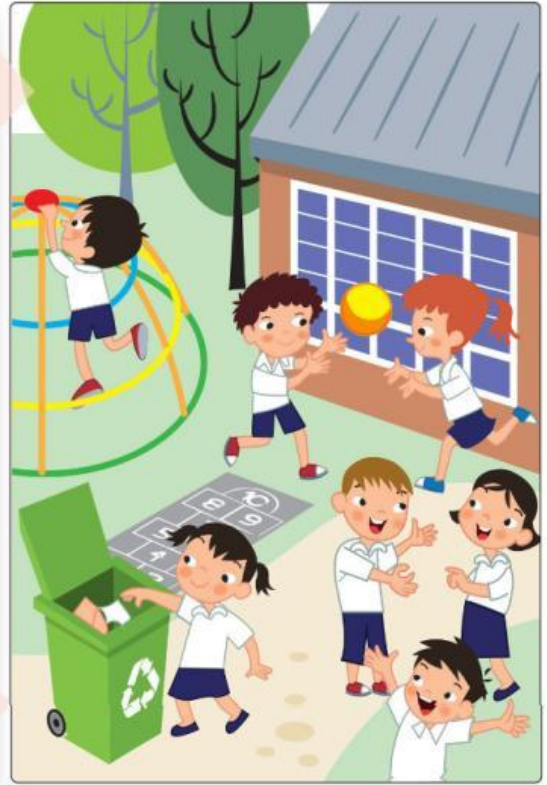


Reading
