

## The eye

Pupil	Protects the eye and spread tears around to keep the eyeball and the socket moist and clean.
Optic nerve	Coloured part of the eye.
Eyelid	Dark opening in the middle of your eye, surrounded by the iris.
Cornea	Specific part of the clear conjunctiva and covers the iris and the pupil.
Iris	It connects to the brain and carries important electrical signals.
