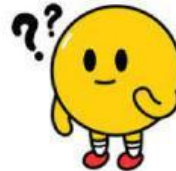
1. **Add:** to put two or more numbers or amounts together to get a total. (añadir)



2. **Answer:** a reaction to a question, letter, phone call, etc.. (contestar)



3. **Ask:** to put a question to someone. (preguntar)



4. **Check:** to make certain that something or someone is correct, safe, or suitable by examining it, him, or her quickly. (comprobar)



5. **Choose:** to decide what you want from two or more things or possibilities. (elegir)



6. **Complete:** to make whole or perfect. (completar)



7. **Copy:** to intentionally make or do something that is the same as an original piece of work. (copiar)



8. **Correct:** in agreement with the true facts or with what is generally accepted. (corregir)



9. **Learn:** to get new knowledge or skill in a subject or activity. (aprender)



10. **Listen:** to pay attention to someone or something in order to hear him, her, or it. (escuchar)



11. **Look:** to direct your eyes in order to see. (mirar)



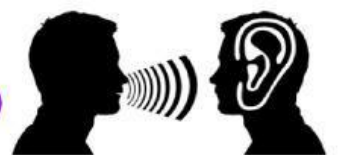
12. **Read:** to look at words and understand what they mean. (leer)



13. **Repeat:** to say or tell people something more than once. (repetir)



14. **Say:** to pronounce words or sounds, to express something. (decir)



15. **Write:** to make symbols that represent letters, words. (escribir)
