Form

Affirmative	Negative
I/We/You/They often play games. He/She/It often play games.	I/We/You/They don't often play games. He/She/It doesn't often play games.
Yes-No questions	Answers
Do we/you/they often play games? Does he/she/it often plays games?	Yes, we/I/they do. / No, we/I/they don't. Yes, he/she/it does. / No, he/she/it doesn't.
Wh- questions	Answers
What do you usually do after school? When does your brother often read comics?	I usually play games. He often reads comics on the weekends.

Usage

- We can use **Present Simple** to talk about habits or things that happen regularly.
My brother **builds** models in her free time. My parents **don't play** tennis on Mondays.
- We can use **adverbs of frequency** (never, seldom, sometimes, often, usually, always, etc.) to talk about how often we do things or how often things happen.
- Adverbs of frequency** often go after the verb "be" or before the main verb.
She is **never** late for school. I **sometimes** read comics after dinner.
- We can use **Present Simple** with **time expressions** (every day, once/twice a week, three times a year, etc.).

They play online games **every Sunday**.

Nam makes vlogs **once a week**.
