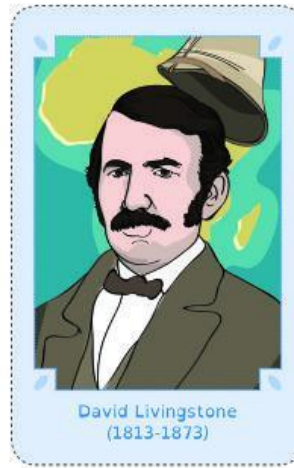
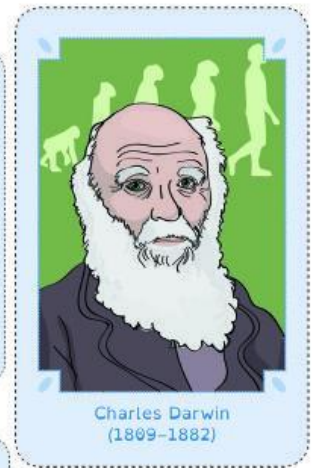




English Mathematician,

Empire.

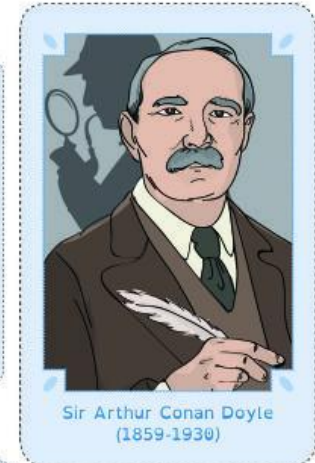
An activist and
