A NOVEL



is a piece of writing on a particular subject in a newspaper or magazine

A MAGAZINE

is a piece of writing that is intended to be acted in a theatre or on radio or television

A NEWSPAPER

is a piece of writing that expresses emotions, experiences, and ideas, especially in short lines using words that rhyme

AN ARTICLE



is a long printed story about imaginary characters and events

A COMIC

is a book that is part of a set, or one into which a very long book is divided

A PLAY

is a large thin book with a paper cover that contains news stories, articles, photographs etc, and is sold weekly or monthly

A JOURNAL



is a serious magazine about a particular subject or a written record of what you have done each day, sometimes including your personal thoughts and feelings



A POEM

is a set of newspapers or magazines published at the same time or a single copy of a newspaper or magazine

A VOLUME

is a paper that is printed and sold usually daily or weekly and that contains news, articles of opinion etc

AN ISSUE



is a magazine or book that contains a set of stories told in pictures with a small amount of writing
