

Stage Directions: Parts of the Stage:

The AUDIENCE is sitting HERE on this side of the stage.

<p>Round African mask</p> 		<p>Aztec mask</p> 
	<p>Oblong African mask</p> 	
<p>Asian mask</p> 		<p>Red/yellow African mask</p> 

Remember the rules:

FIRST, you find Center Stage. Find it above and write in the label.

THEN, you find the Audience. Do you see it?

The 3 spaces **BETWEEN** the Audience and Center Stage are called what? (You can use the word bank below) Write in your answer above in each of the 3 squares.

And the 3 spaces **FURTHEST** from the audience are called what? (Use the word bank below) Write in your answer above. In each of the 3 squares.

The boxes to the **left** and **right** of center stage are also part of center stage, but one side is left and one side is right. Mark each side correctly as Center stage **right** and center stage **left**.

Now, if you are standing Center stage and looking at the audience, which side (3 boxes) of the stage are Stage Left? Add "left" to the correct boxes (so it will look like this = upstage left or downstage left or upstage right or down stage right).

Lastly, mark the boxes that are also Center of their row or side with **Center**.

WORD BANK

You will use **Center stage** 1 time

You will use **Downstage** 3 times

You will use **Upstage** 3 times

You will use **Left** 3 times

You will use **Right** 3 times

You will use **Center** 4 times
