The Terracotta Army

In 1974, some farmers made a very surprising discovery just outside the city of Xi'an in China. They dug the ground to make a well and found a pit containing a life-size clay soldier.

Archaeologists began to dig up the site and they found that there was not just one, but thousands of these clay soldiers. And there weren't just soldiers in the pit. Archaeologists also found weapons and statues of horses pulling chariots.

Qin Shi Huang Di, the first emperor of China, built the army to protect him in his afterlife. He did many great things as emperor. He united the kingdoms that were once at war and created what is now China. He also made money, weights and measurements the same across the new country and he built the first Great Wall of China.
