These cars work with electricity so they don't drive noisily along the highways anymore. It's not possible to drive dangerously because the cars drive themselves. There are no more accidents.
5. And how about crime? Can people live calmly and safely in this perfect world? Yes, they can. Everybody speaks politely and kindly, and there are very few problems in the community. There is a little graffiti, but that's because there's a special place for graffiti artists to paint and draw. People enjoy seeing the new pieces of art.

My dream world isn't the world that we live in now. Most of our streets have trash on them, and the air in a lot of the world is dangerous to breathe. More and more cars fill our streets and highways. And crime is something many people worry about. Still, I believe that my dream world is possible. All the ingredients of my dream world have already appeared – if not in daily life, then at least in the laboratory. We just need to work together, and we can have a much better world sooner than most people imagine.
