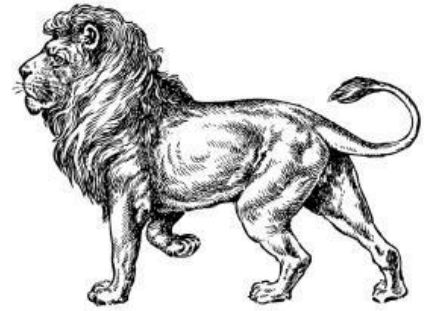


ENGLISH PRACTICAL TEST 3

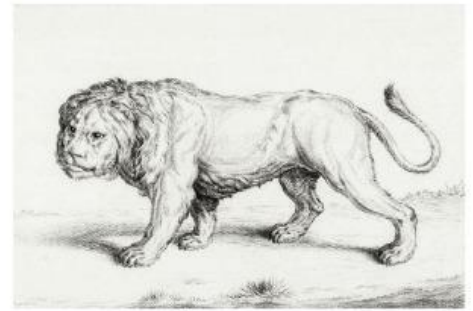

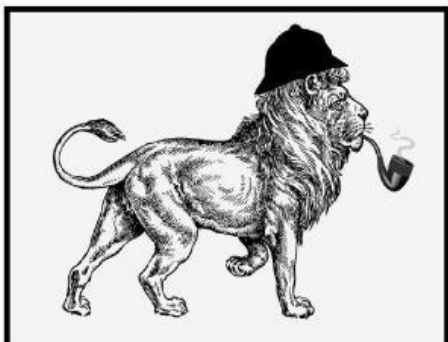
