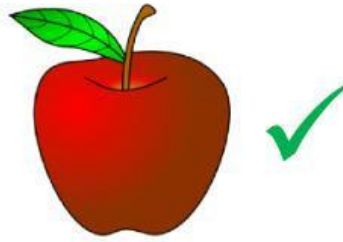

the hamster

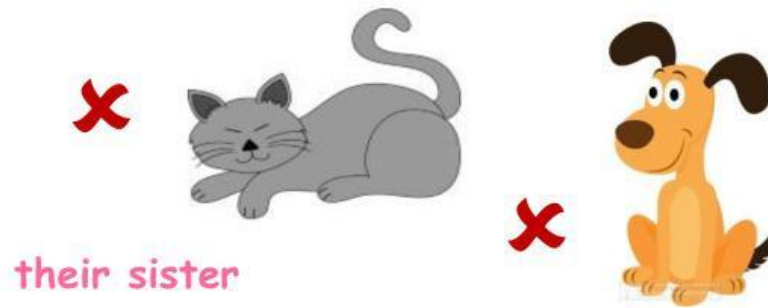
The hamster has got an apple but it hasn't got a ball.

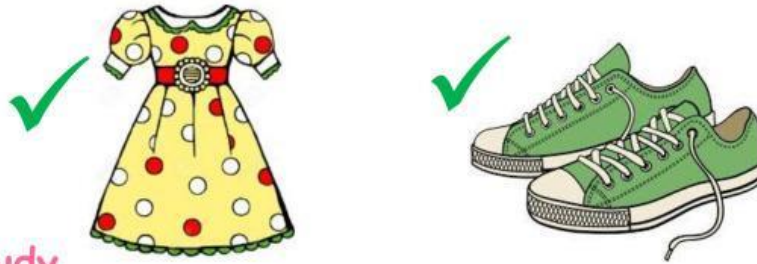

Tom's mother hasn't got a pen and she hasn't got a pencil.

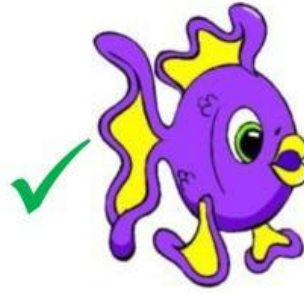

Judy's got a dress and she's got sneakers.



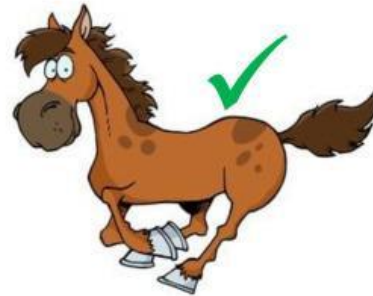

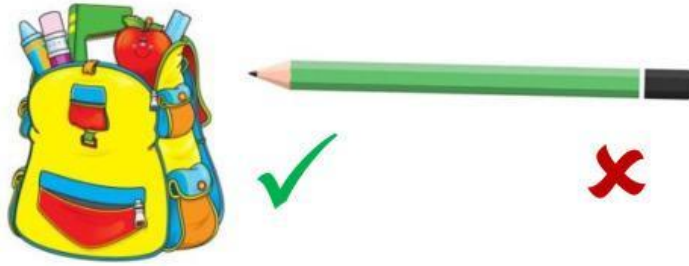
Jack's mother
