

Regular Verbs

- If the verb ends in a voiceless sound, such as /p/, /f/, /s/, /ʃ/, /tʃ/ or /k/, the past simple ending is pronounced **/t/**.

For example, stopped and washed.

- If the verb ends in another voiced sound, /l/, /v/, /n/, /m/, /r/, /b/, /d/, /g/, /w/, /y/, /z/, and vowel sounds the past simple ending is pronounced **/d/**.

For example, played and allowed.

- If the verb ends in /t/ or /d/, the past simple ending is pronounced **/-id/**.

For example, wanted and ended.
